Year 11 Post 16 Options Process

Further to the information I provided during the Year 11 Options evening on the 20th October, I can confirm that your son was emailed the online application form prior to half term both for applying to return to Hitchin Boys' School Sixth Form or alternatively for informing us of his intention to leave the school at the end of his GCSEs. This form was emailed to your son's school Gmail account. If your son does not know his username or password for his school Gmail account, he can obtain this information from his form tutor.

I would like to highlight some key aspects of the application process.

Firstly, if your son is wishing to study any of the following:

Economics, Government & Politics, Sociology or Psychology

then they must attend one of the sample lessons for that subject. Many have already taken place with the final session, for Sociology, taking place at lunchtime on Monday 30^{th} November. Details of when the sample lessons will take place and a sign-up sheet have also been emailed to your son's Gmail account so they can sign up.

Secondly, we have some sixth form students staying behind after school in the sixth form centre to talk to any Year 11 student about their experiences of the subject. These students have been carefully selected to ensure they will not give any inappropriate guidance but will allow Year 11s to look at their folder and ask any questions they feel they need answers to.

Also attached for your information is a copy of the document providing you with information on which course code applies to each subject.

All 155 Year 11 students must complete this process by midnight on Monday 30th November.
