Founders' Day

Founders' Day is on 1 July this year. This is your son's last day of school in year 11; non-attendance will require prior written authorisation from the school. All year 11 are expected to attend in full uniform, meeting their Form Tutors in North Court at 10.30am ready to go over to the service in St Mary's Church. They will be dismissed from the church after the service. This is also your last opportunity to return any remaining books to Woodlands.

Book Returns
