## YEAR 7 TRIP TO KINGSWOOD CENTRE AT GROSVENOR HALL - 16-19 JULY 2017

We are delighted to inform you that we are organising a 3 night residential educational adventure activity course at the Kingswood Centre at Grosvenor Hall in Ashford in July 2017. We are very fortunate to have secured a booking as it is extremely popular with school groups.

Kingswood is the leading residential activity centre provider, welcoming over 130,000 children each year. Their centres provide a rewarding educational programme offering many National Curriculum-linked modules combined with thrilling outdoor and indoor adventure activities, with secure and controlled residential accommodation.

Residential courses organised by the school are an optional, but invaluable part of the National Curriculum. Pupils benefit hugely from the experience, both educationally and socially and I feel certain that the programme which we have chosen this year will prove to be both enjoyable and very worthwhile.


We would like to offer this opportunity to the whole of the Year 7 cohort. The trip will take place from Sunday 16 to Wednesday 19 July 2017. The cost of the trip will be approximately £220 per pupil providing 125 pupils in the year group wish to attend (this will be reduced if a greater number desire to go) and includes return travel by coach, full board, accommodation and a full programme of activities.

In order for your son to attend you will need to pay an initial non-refundable deposit of £60 by **Friday 4 November 2016** followed by 2 further instalments in January and April 2017. The instalment amounts will be advised in a confirmation letter. The preferred method of payment is WisePay, but cheques/cash are still accepted. (Cheques should be made payable to Hitchin Boys' School) if paying by cash please ensure the correct money as change cannot be given. **WisePay will be available from Tuesday 18 October 2016** 

If your son subsequently withdraws from the trip please be aware that some or all of the monies paid may be non-refundable depending on the payment schedule to Kingswood. If you require financial support, please write to the Head Teacher in confidence.

The School reserves the right to withdraw a student from the trip if his behaviour becomes a serious concern as we approach the departure date.
