Dear Parents/Carers

Additional revision support during study leave.

Students will be able to attend lessons during study leave, and these will either take place in their normal classroom, or when it is a subject with multiple classes on at the same time, within departments. Teachers will be available to support students with their revision in these lessons. Study space will also be made available in the dining hall in the mornings for pupils to focus on their own revision.

In addition to this departments will be running extra support, such as afterschool events, breakfast revision sessions on the day of the exam and in some cases additional revision sessions during half term. They will communicate this with you and your child via email so do look out for this.

Maths

In addition to being able to go for revision support during normal maths lesson times, there will be afterschool sessions in maths (3.30 -4.30) on the 3 days prior to their exams this will be Thursday 19th May, Monday 6th June and Friday 10th June. In the morning of their exams they can also turn up for a revision breakfast from 8.30 - to settle any last minute nerves. Please see <u>Appendix A</u> for further information.

English

In addition to being able to get support during timetabled English lesson slots, the English department plan to run walking talking mocks for all the pupils on the afternoons before the exams. Starting at 2.30 until 4pm. This will be on Tuesdays 17th and 24th and 9th May. Students should head to the J block for instructions as to the venue.

Science

Normal lessons times will be staffed for students to revise, in addition science teachers will be on hand directly before the exams, either before school or at lunchtime to support with any last minute queries.

MFL

Before the writing exams for each of the subjects, there will be either a breakfast session if the exam is in the morning, or a lunchtime session if the exam is at 1.30. Please head to MFL corridor for these, German in room 6, French room 10, Spanish Higher room 9 and Spanish Foundation room

Geography

As well as students being able to attend normal lesson slots, there are lunchtime sessions in the Pavillion on the following dates. 16th May, 19th May, 24th May, 26th May, 7th June, and 13th June. Mr Dawson and Ms Pickton's classes run at different times to the majority of the Geographers, and all pupils are welcome to attend these lessons should they wish to for additional revision. The times of these lessons are on the Geography Appendix C.

History

In additional to normal lesson times, Tuesday and Thursdays afterschool have sessions for students aiming at grades 7+. Wednesday lunchtimes sessions focus on securing a grade 4-6. In addition there is an open revision session on Tuesday Lunchtime. Mr Phillipou also plans to run some revision sessions over May half term, further details will be sent by him.

Music

Students are able to attend revision sessions for either of the two classes. This means that there are revision sessions on Wednesday lunchtimes and Fridays from 8.10-9.10 in the morning, as well as sessions on Monday p1 and Thursday p3. Additionally on the day of the exams, there will be revision breakfasts from 8.20 in the morning.

Technology and Food

Normal lesson times will be staffed for revision for the exam.

<u>Drama</u>

An additional session is planned for p3 on Wednesday 18th May, and a further one at Lunchtime on Thursday 19th May - prior to the exam on the afternoon. Students should meet at the auditorium.

Philosophy and Ethics

Revision sessions will run during normal lesson times. With an extended session p3 on May 26th prior to the exam in the afternoon.

Business studies GCSE

The GCSE revision follows normal lesson times, with an additional lunchtime session in N4 prior to each exam in the afternoon.

NB the BTEC Enterprise is complete so there are no revision sessions for this.
