Early Intervention - Year 11 Revision

As the Head of our Upper School, it is my responsibility to ensure ALL our Year 11 students are fully equipped and prepared for this most important GCSE year. With this in mind, I wish to focus on the importance of revision.

Creating a bespoke Revision Timetable

Over the next four weeks I will arrange for each of our Year 11 Tutor Groups to attend tutorial sessions on how to create workable and bespoke revision timetables. These sessions will take our students through a step-by-step process in creating their own revision timetables, as well as how to effectively revise. Students will be invited to join a Year 11 Revision Google Classroom, and this will be shared with parents and carers. I will upload videos and other resources onto this classroom, and you will be able to access your child's revision timetable.

The first sessions will take place week commencing 25th September 2023, and then extend over the following three weeks. As parents, you could assist by checking that your child's Chromebook is fully charged, and that they attend school fully equipped with the basics of a pen, pencil and ruler.

In my experience the creation of a revision timetable does help to relieve some of the stress of exams. Having a revision plan in place that works, and fits around your child's leisure activities will take away some of the fear of the unknown and place him in control of his own revision.
