

Year 13 Destinations Report 2019

As in previous years this summer there was the usual scenario of some past students continuing to be supported by the School in addition to the outgoing Year 13 students. In total there were 127 students in the current cohort with additional past students who were supported by the sixth form pastoral team.

Of these 127 students:

8 were from previous cohorts and 119 were from the 2018-19 outgoing Year 13 cohort so totalling 127.

Overall:

91 students secured a place at University or Music College. However, 4 of these have deferred their place until Sept 2018 meaning 87 HBS students are starting courses in Sept/Oct 2019. Of these 91 students 82 were from the 2018-19 cohort – 71% going onto degree standard education (although at the time of writing 10 students had applied to university but were not placed and are not included). 36 students have gone to a Russell group University (40%).

Of the remaining students who did not gain a place at University this year:

- 9 students have applied for/are planning to apply for apprenticeships.
- 2 students are repeating Year 13 to improve their grades.
- 6 students are taking gap years.
- 1 student has taken up a tennis scholarship at the University of Minnesota.
- 1 student is entering flight training.
- ➤ 1 student is moving abroad to work in Dubai, 1 is gaining work experience in events management, 1 is joining the armed forces and 2 are going into employment.

Degree choices:

Of the 91 students who secured a place at University or Music College this year:

- 26 degrees are in the STEM subjects.
- Business degrees were the most popular with 17 (including marketing, accounting, finance and management.
- 1 student has gone to Cambridge to study Engineering.
