

Year 13 Destinations Report 2020

As in previous years this summer there was the usual scenario of some past students continuing to be supported by the School in addition to the outgoing Year 13 students. In total there were **121** students in the current cohort with additional past students who were supported by the sixth form pastoral team.

Of these 121 students:

7 were from previous cohorts and 114 were from the 2019-20 outgoing Year 13 cohort so totalling 121.

Overall:

95 students secured a place at University or Music College. However, 13 of these have deferred their place until Sept 2021 meaning 82 HBS students are starting courses in Sept/Oct 2020. Of these 82 students 76 were from the 2019-20 cohort – so 66% going on to degree standard education in 2020; 78% going on to degree standard education including those who have deferred to 2021. At the time of writing, 10 students had applied to university but were not placed and are not included. 33 students are going to a Russell Group University (35%).

Of the students who did not gain a place at University this year or did not apply:

- > 7 students have applied for/are planning to apply for apprenticeships.
- 2 students are repeating Year 13 to improve their grades.
- 2 students are taking gap years.
- 1 student has taken up a place studying Music Production/song writing with Starwood Management.
- 1 student is planning to apply to university in the USA for 2021.
- 1 student is undertaking a motorsports course at college and 1 is joining the police.

Degree choices:

Of the 95 students who secured a place at University or Music College this year:

- 33 degrees are in the STEM subjects.
- Business degrees were the most popular with 14 (including marketing, accounting, finance and management).
